

New date for Annual General Meeting & membership consultation



Dear members,

We hope you are doing well.

Unfortunately, we still have to deal with COVID and the COVID measures now. As a result, there was no New Year's Reception. Organising a new event will depend on relaxation of the measures.

The AGM was to be held on March 21st this year. Because we prefer to hold an "analog" AGM, where we can speak to each other personally, the board has decided to postpone the date of the AGM.

The new date scheduled for the AGM will be June 27th, taking into account Article 15, paragraph 1 "The financial year of the association isn't the same as the calendar year. At least one general meeting is held annually, within six months after the end of the financial year," assuming that by then the measures have been relaxed. If this turns out not to be the case, we'll have to resort to holding the AGM digitally after all.
